The Community Room

A large, well lit space situated on the ground floor. The hall is ideal for large meetings and small conferences.

Dimensions: 40' x 22'

Maximum seating: 60 people.

Self-catering facilities and presentation equipment are available on request, including flip charts, a projector, laptop and screen.

The hall also has a loop system for people with a hearing impairment.



The Lounge

A medium-sized, comfortable room situated on the lower ground floor. The room is suitable for meetings and presentations.

Dimensions: 20' x 13'

Maximum seating: 10 people.

Presentation equipment is available on request.



The Quiet Room

A smaller room situated on the lower ground floor. Suitable for one-to-one meetings, supervisions and counselling sessions.

Dimensions: 12' x 6'

Maximum seating: 3 people.



The Training Kitchen

A fully equipped kitchen situated on the lower ground floor. Suitable for practical training sessions or informal meetings.

Dimensions: 23' x 14'

Maximum seating: 16 people.
